Water Lines.

All water lines, together with the easements and permits over and across lands and highways for constructing, maintaining, replacing and operating the same, including all pipes, pumps, structures, tools, appliances and other personal property used in connection therewith, including those located in the States of KANSAS and OKLAHOMA and generally described as follows:

A water line beginning at a point near Cambridge Compressor Station and running southwesterly through Sections 9 and 10, T. 31S., R. 7E., Cowley County, Kansas, parallel to the Dilworth Station to Petrolia Junction system as described in the Original Indenture on page 66, said water line totaling 0.50 miles of 4" pipe in Cowley County, Kansas.

A new 6" water line to supply water to Matfield Compressor Station as described in the Original Indenture page 69, and beginning at a point of connection with the A. T. & S. F. R. R. Company's discharge line 54 feet north and 557 feet west of the south quarter corner of Sec. 14, T. 23S., R. 7E., Butler County, Kansas, thence east and northeasterly through Sections 14, 13 and 12, T. 23S., R. 7E., Butler County, Kansas; thence continuing in a northeasterly
