WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Fifteen Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS
to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and Mortgage to the said parties of the second part its heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in
the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:Beginning at a point in the West Boundary line of the South East Quarter of Section Six (6),
Township Thirteen (13), Range Twenty (20), 80 rods South of the North West corner of said
Quarter Section, thence North 142.8 feet, for a point of beginning, thence East 330 feet,
thence North 60 feet, thence West 330 feet, thence South 60 feet to the point of beginning,
less the West 30 feet thereof for street.with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
parties of the first partdo hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted,
and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrancesThis grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of
Fifteen Hundred and no/100 Dollars, according to the terms of
one certain note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the
first part
to the said parties of the second partand this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But
if default be made in such payments, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this
conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said parties of the
second part its executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof,
in the manner prescribed by law; and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, to-
gether with the cost and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the parties of the first part their
