EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made the 22nd day of March, 1943, by and between The Lakeview Fishing and Shooting Association, incorporation, of Douglas County, Kansas, hereinafter designated as first party, and C. A. Karlan of Shawnee County, Kansas, hereinafter designated as second party, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of November, 1926, first party executed mortgage to The Columbian Title and Trust Company, Trustee, to secure the payment of 170 bonds issued by first party, in the aggregate principal amount of \$25,000.00, which mortgage was recorded on April 4, 1927, in Book 67, Pages 572 to 578, inclusive, in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, by which mortgage the first party conveyed and mortgaged to the grantees therein the following described real estate;

Beginning at a point marked by an iron pipe where the East line of the Southwest quarter of Section 9, Township 12, S. Range 19 E. of the 6th P.M. intersects the South line of the A. T. & S. F. Railway right of way, being about THREE HUNDRED AND FORTY FOUR AND THREE TENTHS FEET (344.3) South of the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 9, thence South TWENTY EIGHT DEGREES AND FORTY FIVE MINUTES WEST SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET (750) to an iron pipe thence, SOUTH TWENTY THREE DEGREES AND NINE MINUTES WEST THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY EIGHT AND EIGHTY ONE HUNDREDTHS FEET (338.81) to an iron pipe in the South line of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 9 thence, SOUTH EIGHTY NINE DEGREES AND THIRTY FIVE MINUTES WEST EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY SEVEN AND SIX TENTHS FEET (857.6) to an iron pipe in the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 9, thence NORTH TWENTY SIX DEGREES AND FORTY FIVE MINUTES EAST ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND NINETY NINE AND THREE TENTHS FEET (1390.3) to an iron pipe in the South line of the A. T. & S. F. Railway right of way, thence SOUTH SIXTY NINE DEGREES AND FIFTY THREE MINUTES EAST SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY THREE FEET along said right of way to an iron pipe at the place of beginning, CONTAINING ABOUT 21.49 acres more or less.

Also beginning at an iron pipe in the South line of the Southwest quarter of Section 9, North eighty Nine degrees and Fourteen Minutes West One Hundred and Thirty One and Five Hundredths Feet (131.05) of the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of said Section 9 thence, SOUTH THIRTY EIGHT DEGREES AND TWENTY FIVE MINUTES EAST TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN AND FIVE TENTHS FEET (215.5) to an iron pipe in the West line of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 12 S. Range 19 E. of the 6th P.M. thence SOUTH FIFTY FOUR DEGREES AND FORTY EIGHT MINUTES EAST SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHT AND FOUR TENTHS FEET (608.4) to an iron pipe, thence SOUTH SEVENTY TWO DEGREES AND THIRTY TWO MINUTES EAST FORTY HUNDRED AND NINETY NINE AND FORTY EIGHT HUNDREDTHS FEET TO AN IRON PIPE, thence SOUTH SEVENTY EIGHT DEGREES AND THIRTY TWO MINUTES EAST THREE HUNDRED AND FORTY NINE AND SIX TENTHS FEET (349.6) to an iron pipe, thence, SOUTH SEVENTY SEVEN DEGREES AND THIRTY TWO MINUTES EAST SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTEEN AND THIRTY EIGHT HUNDREDTHS FEET (618.36) to an iron pipe, thence, SOUTH EIGHTY FIVE DEGREES AND FORTY FOUR MINUTES EAST SEVEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY FEET (760) to an iron pipe on the Section line between Sections 15 & 16 and due South Nine hundred and ten feet of the common corner to Sections 9, 10, 15 & 16, thence NORTH EIGHTY EIGHT DEGREES AND FIFTY TWO MINUTES EAST FIVE HUNDRED AND FIFTY AND EIGHTY FIVE HUNDREDTHS FEET (550.85) to an iron pipe, thence, NORTH ELEVEN DEGREES AND TWELVE MINUTES WEST ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY ONE FEET (131) to an iron pipe, thence, NORTH SEVENTY THREE DEGREES AND ONE MINUTE EAST ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY FIVE FEET (145) to an iron pipe, thence SOUTH NINE DEGREES AND FORTY MINUTES EAST ONE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY ONE FEET (171) to an iron pipe, thence NORTH EIGHTY EIGHT DEGREES AND FIFTY TWO MINUTES EAST TWO HUNDRED AND FORTY TWO FEET (242) to an iron pipe,
