Y., party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors or assigns forever, the following described Real Estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:
