THAT, WHEREAS, the undersigned OSCAR L. TURNER and FRANCES TURNER, Husband and Wife, of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas hereinafter called Mortgagor, has become justly indebted to the United States of America, acting by and through the Secretary of Agriculture, pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by one certain promissory note dated the 9th day of January, 1945, for the principal sum of Two Thousand Twenty-two and no/100 Dollars (\$2022.00) with interest at the rate of three per cent (3%) per annum, principal and interest payable and amortized in installments as therein provided; and

WHEREAS, Mortgagor is desirous of securing the prompt payment of said note, and the several installments of principal and interest at maturity, and any extension or renewal thereof, and any agreement supplementary thereto, and any additional indebtedness accruing to Mortgagee on account of any future advances or expenditures made as hereinafter provided, and the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the said indebtedness and to secure the prompt payment thereof, as the same matures or becomes due, and of any extension or renewal thereof, or of any agreement supplementary thereto and to secure the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained, Mortgagor does hereby and with these presents mortgage and warrant unto Mortgagee the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas to-wit:

The East Half of the Northeast Quarter (S¹/₂NE¹/₄) of SECTION FOURTEEN (14), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Nineteen (19), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and the South Half of the Northwest Quarter (S¹/₂NW¹/₄) of SECTION THIRTEEN (13), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Nineteen (19) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian.

subject to a prior mortgage given by the Mortgagor to the United States of America, dated July 16, 1943, and recorded in Book 88, Page 465, to secure payment of the sum of \$7018.00, plus interest at the rate of 3% per annum, evidenced by a certain promissory note dated July 12, 1943, and executed by the Mortgagor.
