That this satisfaction is executed pursuant to the authority conferred upon the Secretary of Agriculture by Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act (7 U.S.C. 1600 et seq.) and delegated to the Administrator of the Farm Security Administration by Section 2 of the Secretary's Memorandum No. 738 on September 30, 1937 (2 Federal Register 2077, 6 Federal Register 14), and redelegated to me as Regional Director of Region VII, Farm Security Administration by the Administrator of the Farm Security Administration on January 20, 1944 (9 Federal Register 824).
