WHEREAS, by order of the Secretary of Agriculture, dated October 11, 1946, to be effective November 1, 1946, pursuant to the provisions of the Farmers' Home Administration act of 1946 (Public Law 731, 79th Congress, approved August 11, 1946), all subportitles, powers; functions and duties administered by the Farm Security Administration were transferred to the Farmers' Home Administration to be exercised by the Administrator thereof; and
