

21. Martgages may foreclose this mortgage by action in a court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with the laws existing at the time of the commencement thereof, and waid property may be sold on terms and conditions satisfactory to Mortgages.

22. Should this said property be sold under foreolosure: (1) Hortgages or its agent may bid at such sale and purchase said property as a stranger; (2) Hortgagor will pay all costs, fees and other expenses inohrred in connection therewith; (3) Hortgagor does hereby expressly wive all present and future viluation and appraisant laws and, as against the indebtedness hereby secured, Hortgagor waives all exemptions which he has or to which he may be entitled under the Constitution and laws of the "hate of Lamma.

23. Application of the proceeds of such sale shall be made in the following orders (1) be the payment of the cost of foreolosure, inoluding expenses of advertising, selling and conveying such property, abstract of title, court costs and other expenses incident and necessary therets; (2) to the payment of any emcounts that shall have been expended by the Mortgages or that may then be necessary to expend in the payment of insurance greature, targe or other expenditures as herein provided, with ifsterest thereon as aforesaid; (3) to the payment in full of the note herein secured, whether the same shall or shall not have fully matured at the time of said sale; (4) to the payment of secondary liens duly approved and allowed by the court; and (5) the balance, if may, shall be delivered to the Mortgager.
