

It is agreed between the grantant hereto that the part of the first part shall at all times during the life of this indenture, on all taxes, or assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same become due and payable, and that they will keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and lightning in such amounts as shall be specified and directed by the City of Los Angeles of the second part, and in the event that the said City of Los Angeles shall not be satisfied with the amount of insurance so insured, or if the first loss, if any, made payable to the part of the second part, the said City of Los Angeles shall be entitled to require the said City of Los Angeles to insure the said real estate against fire and lightning, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this indenture, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10% from the date of payment until fully paid.

part may pay said taxes and interest on the date of payment and fully repaid.

 THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four thousand and no/100 \$4,000.00 DOLLARS.
 This is the terms of one certain written obligation for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 25th day of September 1897, and by 1 c's terms made payable to the part 3 of the said part with all interest accruing thereon according to the term of said obligation and also to secure any sum of money advanced by the said part 3 of the said part to pay for any insurance or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided, in the event that said part 3 of the said part shall fail to pay the same as provided in this indenture.
