## MORTGAGE

This INDENTURE, Made this 2nd day of Sept 1947, by and between

WITNESSETH, That the Mortgagor, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$ 2000.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents mortgage and warrant unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, the following described property, situated in the county of Douglas  
State of Kansas, to wit:

North Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the  
North Thirteen and Thirty Three Hundredths ( $13\frac{3}{100}$ ) Acres of  
the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), of the Southeast Quarter  
( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section twelve, (12) Township Fourteen (14) South,  
of Range Seventeen (17) East, of Douglas County Kansas.

together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, and the rents, issues and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues and profits until default hereunder), and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following household appliances, which are, and shall be defined to be, fixtures and a part of the realty, and are a portion of the security of the indebtedness herein mentioned:

To HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described property unto the Mortgagee, forever.

Mortgagor covenants with the Mortgagee that he is lawfully seized in fee of the premises hereby conveyed, (or has such other estate as is stated hereinbefore); that he has good right to sell and convey the same, as aforesaid; and that he will warrant and defend the aforesaid title thereto against the claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
