

This Indenture, made the first day of A.D. 1947, between THE MUTUAL BENEFIT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation under the laws of New Jersey, located in the City of Newark in the State of New Jersey, party of the first part, and [REDACTED] party of the second part, witnesseth:

Whereas, John J. Nitzel and wife, by a mortgage dated the 11th day of April, A.D. 1947, and recorded in book 52 at page 361 of the records of the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, for the consideration therein mentioned, and to secure the payment of the money therein specified, did convey certain real estate into the party of the first part;

And Whereas, the said party of the first part, at the request of the said party of the second part, has agreed to give up and surrender that part of said real estate which is hereinafter described and retain the residue thereof as security:

Now, Therefore, in pursuance of said agreement, and in consideration of the sum of

fifteen hundred (\$1,500.00)

Dollars to it paid, the said party of the first part does hereby release and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, all that part of said real estate, situate in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, to wit:

54 acres, more or less, described as beginning at a point on the South line of the Southeast quarter of Section 18, Township 12, Range 19, 970.32 feet West of the Southeast corner of said quarter-section, thence West along the South line of said quarter-section to a point 16 rods East of the Southwest corner of said quarter-section, thence North 10 rods, thence West parallel with the South line of said quarter-section 16 rods to the West line thereof, thence North on the West line of the quarter section 1,121.95 feet, thence East parallel with the South line of said quarter section 1,023.6 feet to an iron pin, thence North 190.59 feet to an iron pin, thence East parallel with the South line of said quarter section 754.68 feet to an iron pin; thence South parallel with the last line of said quarter-section 1,477.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all the right, title and interest of the said party of the first part in and to the same, to the intent that the real estate hereby released and quit-claimed shall be discharged from the lien of said mortgage, and that the residue thereof shall remain to the said party of the first part, as heretofore.
