Witnesseth: That the said part 1es of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty Five & no/100 DOLLARS to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha ~~ve~~ sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and Mortgage to the said part 1es of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows to wit:


A tract of ground described as; Beginning 1 Rod West of the S.W. corner of N.W. 1/4 or the S.W. 1/4 of Section #29, Twp 12, Range #30, thence East 7 rods, thence North 11 1/4 rods, thence West 7 rods, thence South 11 1/4 rods to place of Beginning and; Beginning at a point 1 rod West of the S.W. corner of the N.W. Quarter of Section 29 Township 12 Range 20, thence North 11 1/4 rods thence West 7 rods, thence South 11 1/4 rods, thence East 7 rods to the place of beginning, being a portion of Block 8 in that part of the City known as North Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1es of the first part therein. And the said George Baker and Josephine Baker husband and wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances with no exceptions.

But if default be made in such payments, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part 1es of the second part their executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part 1es making such sale, on demand, to said George Baker and Josephine Baker their heirs and assigns


