## RELEASE DEED

WHEREAS, FRANK S. BUTCHER and C. BELLE BUTCHER, husband and wife, by their certain Mortgage dated May 1, 1922, recorded in Book 62 of Mortgages on Page 382 of the records of Douglas County, Kansas, conveyed and mortgaged unto THE LIBERTY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF SALINA, KANSAS, certain real estate therein described, located in Douglas County, Kansas, to secure the sum of \$9,000.00, and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 1922, pursuant to an order and resolution of the Federal Farm Loan Board, the name of THE LIBERTY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF SALINA, KANSAS, was duly and legally changed to THE LIBERTY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, and on May 18, 1922, pursuant to an order and resolution of the Federal Farm Loan Board, the name of THE LIBERTY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI was duly and legally changed to KANSAS CITY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, and

WHEREAS, H.M. Langworthy was duly and regularly appointed Receiver of said KANSAS CITY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, by the Federal Farm Loan Board on February 8, 1928, effective at the close of February 15, 1928, and

WHEREAS, H.M. Langworthy, Receiver of the KANSAS CITY JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, by and with the approval of the Federal Farm Loan Board, duly and regularly assigned said mortgage to PHOENIX JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, by written instrument of assignment dated as at the beginning of July 1, 1931, and,

WHEREAS, PHOENIX JOINT STOCK LAND BANK OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, a corporation, duly and regularly assigned said mortgage to THE OHIO NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio, by written instrument of Assignment, dated the 27th day of May, 1940, and

WHEREAS, said note and mortgage have been fully paid and said FRANK S. BUTCHER and C. BELLE BUTCHER, husband and wife, are entitled to a full release of said mortgage.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that THE OHIO NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY does hereby acknowledge full satisfaction of said mortgage and does hereby release the above mentioned real estate from the lien of said mortgage.
