

This Indenture, Made this 5th day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, between Dorothy Gertrude Goodrick, a single woman

of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, party of the first part, and The Lawrence Building and Loan Association

part Y of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said part Y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS

to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by this indenture do grant, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said part Y of the second part, the following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The North Half of the West Half of Park Lot 22 and the North Half of the East Half of Park Lot 24, all in the city of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said part Y of the first part therein.

And the said part Y of the first part do hereby covenant and agree at the delivery hereof, she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances,

and that she will warrant and defend the same against all persons making lawful claim thereto. It is agreed between the parties hereto that the part Y of the first part shall at all times during the life of this indenture, pay all taxes and assessments, that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same becomes due and payable, and the \$110.00 W.M.L. being added upon and real estate insured against fire and tornado in such sum and by such insurance company as shall be specified and directed by the part Y of the second part, the loss, if any, made payable to the part Y of the second part to the extent of 10% interest. And in the event that said part Y of the first part fail to pay the same taxes and assessments becoming due and payable or to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the part Y of the second part shall pay the same insurance, or other, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this indenture, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10% from the date of payment until fully repaid.

THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS,

according to the terms of ONE certain written obligation for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 5th day of November 1948 and by L.T.S. terms made payable to the part Y of the second part, with all interest accruing thereon according to the terms of said obligation and also to secure any sum or sums of money advanced by the said part Y of the second part to pay for any insurance or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided, in the event that said part Y of the first part shall fail to pay the same as provided in this indenture.

And this indenture shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified, and the obligation contained therein fully discharged. If default be made in such payments or any part thereof or any obligation created thereby, or interest thereon, or if the taxes on said real estate are not paid when the same become due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept up, as provided herein, or if the buildings on said real estate are not kept in as good repair as they are now, or if the same is committed on said premises, then this concession shall become absolute and the whole sum remaining unpaid, and all of the obligations created for in this indenture, and the right of entry on the part Y of the second part shall immediately mature and become due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, without notice, and it shall be lawful for the said part Y of the second part to enter upon the said premises and take possession of the said premises and all the improvements thereto in the manner prescribed by law and to have and to recover appointed to collect the rents and benefits accruing therefrom, and to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then unpaid of principal and interest, together with the costs and charges incident thereto, and the surplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part Y of the second part to the parties hereto, in the terms and provisions of this indenture and such and every obligation therein contained, and all benefits accruing therefrom, shall extend and inure to, and be obligatory upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, assigns and successors of the respective parties hereto.
