That the United States of America does hereby acknowledge and certify that a certain real estate mortgage dated the 20th day of September, 1941, made and executed by Roy Vandeventer and Ella Evelyn Vandeventer, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, on the following described real estate located in Douglas County, State of Kansas, to wit:

The Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of SECTION EIGHT (8), Township Fifteen (15) South, Range Twenty-one (21), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, subject to an oil and gas lease to H. H. Smith, dated May 19, 1917, recorded in Book 101, Page 224, and assignments thereof, and subject to a deed to the State of Kansas, for highway purposes, dated August 3, 1937, and recorded in Book 140, Page 9, and also

All the right, title and interest of the Mortgagors in and to the above described oil and gas lease, and in and to the deed for highway purposes referred to above,

together with all rents and other revenues or incomes therefrom, including all rents, royalties, bonuses, payments, delay moneys and other incomes due or to become due under the terms of said oil and gas lease.

to secure the payment of Eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-nine and No/100-

Dollars (\$8,229.00), which mortgage is recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Douglas County, Kansas, in Book 88,

Page 22, of the records of said county, together with the debt secured thereby, is fully paid, satisfied and discharged.

This instrument is executed and delivered pursuant to the authorities conferred by the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. 1000, et seq.), the Farmers Home Administration Act of 1946 (Note to 7 U.S.C. 1001), the delegation by the Secretary of Agriculture to the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration at 11 Federal Register 12520 and the delegation by the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration to the State Directors of the Farmers Home Administration (which was approved by the Secretary of Agriculture) at 13 Federal Register 5139.
