

And the Company covenants and agrees to observe and comply with the provisions of said sections, as so amended and modified, so long as any bonds of Series A or Series B issued under and secured by the Indenture, or this Supplemental Indenture shall be outstanding.

SECTION 5. All the covenants, stipulations, promises and agreements in this First Supplemental Indenture contained by or on behalf of the Company or of the Trustee shall inure to and bind their respective successors and assigns as well as any and all obligors on the Bonds, as defined in § 16.14 of the Original Indenture.

SECTION 6. Although this First Supplemental Indenture is dated for convenience and for the purpose of reference as of March 1, 1949, the actual dates of execution by the Company and by the Trustee are as indicated by their respective acknowledgments hereto, annexed.

SECTION 7. In order to facilitate the recording or filing of this First Supplemental Indenture, the same may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts shall together constitute but one and the same instrument.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, THE AMERICAN TELEPHONE COMPANY has caused this First Supplemental Indenture to be signed in its corporate name and behalf by its President or one of its Vice Presidents and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Secretary or one of its Assistant Secretaries; and The City National Bank and Trust Company of Kansas City in token of its acceptance of the trust hereby created has caused this Supplemental Indenture to be signed in its corporate name and behalf by its President or one of its Vice Presidents and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Trust
