MORTGAGE

(No. 52 B)

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This Indenture, Made this 8th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-nine between Margarete Walker, a single woman

of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas part Y of the first part, and The Lawrence Building and Loan Association part Y of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said part Y of the first part, for consideration of the sum of Five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS

to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, by her and by this indenture do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said part Y of the second part, the following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The West half (1/2) of Lots 121, 123 and 125, in Block 44, in that part of the City of Lawrence, in Douglas County, Kansas, known as West Lawrence

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said part Y of the first part therein.

And the said part Y of this first part do GRANT hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

and that she will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim thereto. It is agreed between the parties hereto that the part Y of the first part shall as all times during the life of the indenture, pay all taxes or assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same become due and payable, and that SHE will keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and tornado in such sums and by such insurance company as shall be specified and directed by the part Y of the second part, the less, if any, made payable to the part Y of the second part to the extent of 1% interest. And in the event that said part Y of the first part shall fail to pay such taxes when the same become due and payable or to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the part Y of the second part may pay said taxes and insurance, or other, and the amount so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness secured by this indenture, and shall bear interest at the rate of 10% from the date of payment until fully repaid.

THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,

according to the terms of ONE certain written obligation for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 8th day of August 1949, and by its terms made payable to the part Y of the second part, with all interest accruing thereon according to the terms of said obligation and also to secure any sum or sums of money advanced by the said part Y of the second part to pay for any insurance or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided, in the event that said part Y of the first part shall fail to pay the same as provided in this indenture.

And this covenant shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified, and the obligation contained therein fully discharged. If default be made in such payments or any part thereof or any obligation crossed thereby, or interest thereon, or if the taxes on said real estate are not kept in as good repair as they are become due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept up, as provided herein, or if the buildings on said real estate are not kept in as good repair as they are now, or if waste is committed on said premises, then this covenant shall become absolute and the whole sum remaining unpaid, and all of the obligations now, or if waste is committed on said premises, then this covenant shall become absolute and the whole sum remaining unpaid, and all of the obligations provided for in said written obligation, for the security of which this indenture is given, shall immediately mature and become due and payable at the option of the holder hereof, without notice, and it shall be lawful for the said part Y of the second part to take possession of the said premises and all the improvements thereon in the manner provided by law and to have a receiver appointed to collect the rents and benefits accruing to the said premises and to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of all moneys arising from such sale to retain (absent) and to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and the proceeds, if any there be, shall be paid by the part Y of the second part to the part Y of the first part, together with the costs and charges incident thereto, and the surplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part Y of the second part to the part Y of the first part.

It is agreed by the parties hereto that the terms and provisions of this indenture and each and every obligation therein contained, and all benefits accruing therefrom, shall extend and inure to, and be obligatory upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, assigns and successors of the respective parties herein.
