<u>Five Hundred and Ninety Two</u> DOLLARS		
to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents doth		
grant, bargain, sell and Mortgage to the said part <u>2</u> of the second part <u>their</u> heirs and assigns,		
forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of <u>Douglas</u> and
