REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE FOR KANSAS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, the undersigned GEORGE M. CHRISTIAN and EVELYN CHRISTIAN,  
husband and wife,

of the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, hereinafter called Mortgagor, has become justly  
indebted to SHAWNEE FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION,

Topeka, Kansas.

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas, hereinafter  
called Mortgagor, as evidenced by one certain promissory note dated the 1st day of October,  
1947, for the principal sum of Ten Thousand Eight Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$10,800.00), with interest at the rate of three percent (3%) per annum, principal and interest payable and  
amortized in installments as therein provided and in accordance with the terms thereof, the first installment shall be in the amount of \$100, payable on the 31st day of March, 1948; the next succeeding thirty-nine installments  
shall be in the amount of \$467.20— in each, payable annually thereafter; and the final installment shall be in the  
amount of any remaining principal and interest, payable forty (40) years from the date of said note; and

WHEREAS, Mortgagor is desirous of securing the prompt payment of said note, and the several installments of principal  
and interest at maturity, and any extension or renewal thereof, and any agreement supplementary thereto, and any additional  
indebtedness on account of any future advances or expenditures made as hereinafter provided, and the performance  
of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the said indebtedness and to secure the prompt payment thereof, as the same  
matures or becomes due, and of any extension or renewal thereof, or of any agreement supplementary thereto, and to  
secure the performances of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor herein contained, Mortgagor does hereby  
and with these presents mortgage and warrant unto Mortgagor the following described real estate situated in the County  
of Douglas, State of Kansas, to wit:

The North Half of the Southwest Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4} \text{ SW} \frac{1}{4}$ ), the West  
Half of the South One Hundred Acres of the Southeast Quarter  
( $\frac{1}{2} \text{ SE} \frac{1}{4} \text{ SW} \frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest  
Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4} \text{ SW} \frac{1}{4}$ ) of SECTION TWELVE (12), Township Fifteen  
(15) South, Range Eighteen (18) East of the Sixth Principal  
Meridian; SUBJECT TO rights of record;

Being the same land that was conveyed to the Mortgagors as  
joint tenants by a certain deed executed by Elmer John  
Winterman and Dorothy M. Winterman, husband and wife,  
and intended to be recorded simultaneously herewith.

together with all rents and other revenues or incomes therefrom, and all and singular, the rights, easements, hereditaments,  
and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, and all improvements and personal prop-  
erty now or hereafter attached to or reasonably necessary to the use of the real property herein described, all of which  
property is sometimes hereinafter designated as "said property".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, said property before mentioned unto Mortgagor and its assigns forever.

MORTGAGOR, for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, does hereby and by these presents  
covenant and agree:

1. To pay promptly all installments of principal and interest as they become due according to the terms of the said  
promissory note, and of any agreements supplementary thereto, and any other indebtedness owing by the Mortgagor to  
the Mortgagor and secured hereby. In the event this mortgage and the note secured hereby are insured under the  
provisions of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, as amended, the Mortgagor will pay all such installments of principal  
and interest, and such other amounts as the Mortgagor is required to pay to the Mortgagor under this mortgage, to the  
United States of America, acting by and through the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration (hereinafter  
referred to as "the Government").
