4. *Warshaw Building Site*: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot Number Six (6), Block Number Seven (7), Thibow, now a part of the City of Bonner Springs, thence Northerly along the Southwesterly side of Second Street, Fifty-four (54) feet, thence Southeasterly along the Southwesterly side of Second Street, Fifty-four (54) feet, thence Southeasterly along the Southwesterly side of Second Street, Fifty-four (54) feet, thence Southeasterly at right angles and parallel with Second Street to the Southwest corner of said Lot Number Six (6), Block Number Six (6), One Hundred Fifty (150) feet to the point of beginning, being a part of the City of Bonner Springs, according to the record plat thereof.

46. *Electricity Sediment Sites*: All of that part of Lot Six (6) and Black Spine (7), Thibodeau, was a part of Bonner Springs, as shown on the map of the latter city. The following is a description of the same as recorded just thereof, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the East corner of Lot Six (6), Block Seven (7), Thibodeau, and at a point equidistant to said Lot and Lot Five of said Block and on the Southwesterly line of Cedar Street in Bonner Springs; thence Northerly, along the Northerly side of said Lot Six (6), Ninety (90) feet; thence Southerly, parallel with Second Street, Eighty-three and One-half (83½) feet; thence Southerly, parallel with Third Street, Eighty-three and One-half (83½) feet; thence Northerly, along the Southwesterly side of said Lot Six (6), Eighty-three and One-half (83½) feet to the point of beginning.
