to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and Mortgate to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit:

The South Half of Lots 8 and 13 and all of Lots 10 and 11, less the
South 5 feet of said Lots 10 and 11, and all of Lots 9 and 12, all

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
And the said Joseph N. Raybern and Margaret E. Raybern, husband and wife
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of
the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all
incumbrances — no exceptions

Raybern and Margaret E. Raybern, their heirs and assigns
