

Also all transmission and distribution systems used for the transmission and distribution of electricity, steam, water, gas and other agencies for light, heat, cold or power or any other purpose whatsoever, whether underground or overhead, surface or otherwise, now owned by the Company or, subject to the provisions of Article XII, which it may hereafter acquire, including all poles, poles, wires, cables, conduits, mains, pipes, tubes, drains, furnaces, switchboards, transformers, insulators, meters, lamps, fuses, junction boxes, water pumping stations, regulator stations, town border metering stations, and other electric, steam, water and gas fixtures and apparatus; the distribution and transmission lines now owned by the Company being more particularly as follows (but reference to particular distribution systems and transmission lines shall not be deemed to exclude any others not mentioned):

ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION LINES.

Line 1. A 66,000 volt, steel tower, electric transmission line, approximately one hundred eighty-seven (187) miles in length, extending from the steam electric generating plant in the City of Hutchinson, Reno County, through the City of McPherson, in McPherson County, through the City of Salina, in Saline County, through the City of Ableson, in Dickinson County, through the City of Junction City, in Geary County, through Wamego, Kansas County to the steam electric generating station at Tecumseh, near the City of Topeka, in Shawnee County.

Line 2. A 33,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately twenty-seven (27) miles long, extending from the steam electric generating station at Hutchinson, in Reno County, through the Town of Whiteside, in Reno County, through the Town of Parridge, in Reno County, through the Town of Arlington, in Reno County, to the Town of Langdon, in Reno County; all of the Company's interest in a 33,000 volt wood pole electric transmission line approximately 6.5 miles in length, extending from the town of Langdon in Reno County to the town of Turon in Reno County, under the contract between The Prewitt Power and Water Company and the City of Turon dated February 1, 1921; and a 33,000 volt wood pole electric transmission line approximately 9.5 miles in length, extending from the town of Turon in Reno County, to the Town of Preston, in Pratt County.

Line 3. A 6,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately seventeen and five-tenths (17.5) miles in length, extending from the Town of Preston, in Pratt County, through the Town of Iuka, in Pratt County, to a point two (2) miles south of Iuka.

Line 4. A 33,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately twenty-seven (27) miles in length, extending from the Town of Parridge, in Reno County, through the Town of Sylvia, in Reno County, through the Town of Zenith, in Stafford County, to the Town of Stafford, in Stafford County.

Line 5. A 2,300 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately one hundred and thirty (130) miles in length, extending from a point of junction with Line 4 due west of Ableson, in Reno County, to Ableson, in Reno County; and a 2,300 volt wood pole electric transmission line approximately 6 miles in length, extending from a point south of Ableson in Reno County to Prewitt in Reno County.
