

SATISFACTION OF REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the United States of America does hereby acknowledge and certify that a certain real estate mortgage dated the 7th day of March, 1944, made and executed by Joseph H. Clough and Thelma H. Clough in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, on the following described real estate located in Douglas County, State of Kansas, to wit:

A tract of land beginning at the Northeast corner of the Northwest Fractional Quarter (NW 1/4) of SECTION EIGHTEEN (18), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Eighteen (18), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, thence West 81.03 rods, thence South 100 rods, thence West 50 rods to the West line of said fractional quarter section, thence South 60 rods to the Southwest corner of said quarter section, thence East 131.03 rods, more or less, to the Southeast corner of said quarter section, thence North 160 rods to the place of beginning, containing 100 acres, more or less, and also all of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of SECTION SEVEN (7), Township Thirteen (13) South, Range Eighteen (18), East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, except a tract on the West side thereof 50 rods wide extended the whole length of said quarter section, containing 80.65 acres, more or less.

to secure the payment of Eight Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-seven and no/100 Dollars (\$ 8,227.00), which mortgage is recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Douglas County, Kansas, in Book 88, Page 551, of the records of said county, together with the debt secured thereby, is fully paid, satisfied and discharged.

This instrument is executed and delivered pursuant to the authorities conferred by the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. 1000, et seq.), the Farmers Home Administration Act of 1946 (Note to 7 U.S.C. 1001), the delegation by the Secretary of Agriculture to the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration at 11 Federal Register 12520 and the delegation by the Administrator of the Farmers Home Administration to the State Directors of the Farmers Home Administration (which was approved by the Secretary of Agriculture) at 13 Federal Register 5139.
