to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, he has sold, and by this indenture do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and MORTGAGE to the said party of the second part, the following described real estate situated and being in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

Lets Numbered One hundred Fourteen (114), One hundred

Sixteen (116), One hundred Eighteen (118), and the East

Fifteen (15) feet of South fifty (50) feet of Lot One

hundred twenty (120), all on King Street, in Baldwin

City, Douglas County, Kansas

with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said part 1st of the first part therein.

And the said part 100 of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances.

and that they will warrant and defend the same against all parties making lawful claim thereto. It is agreed between the parties hereto that the part _____ of the first part shall be at times during the life of the insured, pay all taxes and assessments that may be levied or assessed against said real estate when the same become due and payable, and they will keep the buildings upon said real estate insured against fire and theft in such a manner and to such an extent as shall be specified and directed by the party _____ of the second part, the first insurance, if any, made by party _____ of the second part to the extent of their interest. "And it is event that said party ABC of the first part shall fail to pay by such terms when the same become due and payable or to keep said premises insured as herein provided, then the party _____ of the second part may pay said taxes and insurances, or either, and the amounts so paid shall become a part of the indebtedness, secured by this indenture, and shall be interest at the rate of 10% from the date of payment until fully repaid.

THIS GRANT is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS.

according to the terms of a certain written obligation for the payment of said sum of money, executed on the 23rd day of January 1950, and by its terms made payable to the part Y of the second part, with all interest accruing thereon according to the terms of said obligation and also to secure any sum or sums of money advanced by the said part Y of the second part to pay for any insurance or to discharge any taxes with interest thereon as herein provided in the event that said part Y of the first part shall fail to pay the same as provided in this indenture.
