

ever which they may have acquired under and by virtue of or arising from said General Mortgage in and to all property of every kind or character whatsoever, and whatsoever situated, real, personal, or mixed, conveyed or intended to be conveyed by said General Mortgage, all to the same effect as if herein provided, and shall be subject to the same claims, claims, and demands which they, as such trustees, may have acquired by virtue of said General Mortgage; and (3) consent and direct that said General Mortgage be discharged of record, both as a real estate mortgage and as a chified mortgage, and authorize the recording or other proper official of each county or parish and state in which said General Mortgage has been recorded or filed to discharge the same of record in his office.
