DISCHARGE OF MORTGAGE

THIS CERTIFIES That a certain mortgage executed by Elmer L. Knapp and Anna M. Knapp, his wife of Lawrence, Kansas mortgagee, to

National Life Insurance Company, (a corporation organized under the laws of Vermont, of Montpelier, in the County of Washington, in said State) dated the 6th day of August A. D. 1944 upon the following described property situated in the County of Douglas State of Kansas: The north 75 feet of the west 37½ feet of Park Lot 12, and the north 75 feet of Park Lots numbered 14 and 16 respectively in the city of Lawrence, being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Park Lot 16; thence running East on the north lines of Lots 12, 14 and 16, 137½ feet; thence running south parallel with the west line of Lot 12, 75 feet; thence west parallel with said north line 137½ feet to the west line of said lot 16; thence north on said west line 75 feet to the place of beginning in city of Lawrence
