## MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 5th day of October, 1950, by and between  
Edgar A. Harrison and Alice Jeanne Harrison, his wife,  
of Lawrence, Kansas, Mortgagor, and

CAPITOL FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation organized and existing  
under the laws of the United States, Mortgagee:

WITNESSETH, That the Mortgagor, for and in consideration of the sum of - - - Twelve Thousand  
Three Hundred Fifty and no/100 - Dollars (\$12,350.00), the receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged, does by these presents mortgage and warrant unto the Mortgagee, its successors and  
assigns, forever, the following-described property, situated in the county of Douglas  
State of Kansas, to wit:

Part of "Reserve" in Lane's First Addition to the City of Lawrence, Douglas  
County, Kansas, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the South line  
of the Block bounded on the West by Illinois Street, on the South by Eighth  
Street, and on the East by Mississippi Street, said point being on the North  
line of Eighth Street 89 feet East of the East line of Illinois Street; thence  
North parallel with Illinois Street 76.5 feet; thence East parallel with Eighth  
Street 7 feet; thence North parallel with Illinois Street 27 feet; thence East  
parallel with Eighth Street 58.2 feet; thence South parallel with Illinois Street  
27 feet; thence East parallel with Eighth Street 7 feet; thence South parallel with  
Illinois Street 76.5 feet to the North line of Eighth Street; thence West along  
the North line of Eighth Street 72.2 feet to the point of beginning.
