THIS INDENTURE, Made this 12th day of October, 1950, by and between
William P. Smith and June Nickel Smith, his wife

under the laws of the United States, Mortgagee:

WITNESSETH, That the Mortgagee, for and in consideration of the sum of - - - - - Ninety-seven

acknowledged, does by these presents mortgage and warrant unto the Mortgagee, its successors and
