## MORTGAGORS COVENANT AND AGREE:

Q.

1. To keep said premises insured for the protection of Mortgages in such manner, in such mounts and in such companies as Mortgages may from time to time approve, and to keep the policies therefor, properly endowed, on deposit with Mortgages; and that loss proceeds (less expenses of collection) shall, at Mortgages's option, be applied on said indebtdoes, whether due or not, or to the restoration of said improvements.

2. To pay all taxes and special assessments of any kind that have been or may be levied or assessed within the State of Kanasa upon said premises, or any part thereof, or upon the note or debt secured hereby, or upon the interest of Mortgagee in said premises or in said note or said debt, and procure and deliver to Mortgage, at its home office, ten days before the day fixed by law for the first interest or panty to accrue thereon, the official receipt of the proper officer showing payment of all such taxes and assessments.

3. To keep stid premises free from all prior liens and upon demand of Mortgagee to pay and procure release of any lien which in any way may impair the security of this mortgage.

4. In the event of default by Mortgagers under paragraphs 1, 2 or 3 above. Mortgages, at its option (whether electing to declare the whole indebtedness hereby secured due and collectible or not), may (a) effect the insurance above provided for and pay the reasonable premiums and charges therefor; (b) pay all aid taxes and assessments without determining the validity thereof (unless Mortgages have instituted proper legal pro-ceedings to test the validity of such taxes and all costs and express there instituted proper legal pro-ceedings to test the validity of such taxes and all costs and express herein covenanted to be paid by Mortgagers; and all sock and is business with interest thereon from the time of payment at the highest rate allowed by law, shall be deemed a part of the indebtedness secured by this mortgage and shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagers; to Mortgages.

5. To keep the buildings and other improvements now or hereafter erected in good condition and repair, not to commit or suffer any waste or any use of said premises contrary to restrictions of record or contrary to haw, ordinances or regulations of proper vublic authority, not to remodel the improvements for other than residence use, not to assign or pledge any lease of the premises and not to procure or accept preparament of rent for more than one month unless with the written consent of Mortgagee, and to permit Mortgagee to enter at all reasonable times for the purpose of inspecting the premises.

6. That they will pay the indebiedness hereby secured promptly and in full compliance with the terms of said note and this mortgage, and that the time of payment of said indebiedness, or of any portion thereof, may be extended or renewed, and any portions of the premises herein described may, without notice, be released from the line here(or, without released from the line here(or, without released) from the instrument upon the remainder of said premises for the full amount of said indebtedness then remaining upnaid, and no change in the ownership of said premises shall release, reduce or otherwise affect any such personal liability of any persons.

## IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

In case default shall be made in the payment of any instalment of said note or of interest thereon when due or if there shall be a failure on the part of Mortgagors to comply with any covenant, condition or pryvision of this mortgage, then the said note and the whole indetectioness secured by this mortgage, including all payments for target assessments, insufance premiums, liens, costs and expenses herein specified shall, at the option of Mortgages and without notice to Mortgagors (such notice being hereby expressly waived), become due and collectible at once by foreclosure or otherwise.

2. As further security for the fulfilment of Mortgagors' obligations, Mortgagors hereby assign to Mortgagee all present and future leases and all rents, issues and profits for the premises, and upon any default, Mortgagee is hereby empowered to enter upon and take possession of the premises, to let the same, to receive all rents, issues and profits therefore of either due or to become due and to apply such receipts in payment of necessary charges and expenses and on account of said indebtedness, and Mortgagee's acts, as authorized in this paragraph, all not in any way affect its rights of foreclosure and appointment of a receiver, or other rights of enforcement, as hereinafter provided.

3. If the note and mortgage, or either of them, shall be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or foreelosure, or if Mortgagee volunitarily or involuntarily becomes or is made a party to any suit or proceeding relating to the premises or to this mortgage or said note. Mortgageon shall reimburse Mortgage for its reasonable costs and for expense of procuring abstracts or other evidences of title and title insurance in connection therewith:

4. If any proceedings shall be brought to forcelose this mortgage or to collect the indebtedness hereby secured, Mortgages shall be entitled as a matter of right, without notice to Mortgagors or any person claiming under them and without regard to the adequacy of the security or whether the same shall then be occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption as a homestead, to the immediate appointment of a receiver with power to take possession of the premises, lease the same, collect all rentias and profits thereof and hold and apply the receipts as the court may order for maintenance of the security and on account of said indebtedness.

5. Mortgages shall be subrogated to the lien of any and all prior incumbrances, liens or charges paid and discharged from the proceeds of the note hereby secured, and even though said prior liens have been released of record, the repayment of said note shall be secured by such liens on the portions of said premises affected thereby to the extent of such payments, respectively.

6. Whenever by the terms of this instrument or of said note Mortgagee is given any option, such option may be exercised when the right accrues, or at any time thereafter.

7. All Mortgagors shall be jointly and severally liable for fulfillment of their covenants and agreements herein contained, and all provisions of this mortgage shall inure to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, grantees, lessees and assigns of the parties hereto, respectively.
