

To Have and To Hold the Same With the Appurtenances, unto the said mortgagors, their heirs and assigns, forever freed, exonerated and discharged of and from the lien of said mortgage, and of every part thereof; provided always, nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall in any wise affect, alter or diminish the lien or encumbrance of the aforesaid mortgage on the remaining part of said real estate, described in said mortgage, or the remedies at law for recovering from the said part of said real estate, the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, the balance of said mortgage indebtedness with interest.

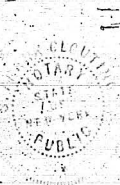
