AND #HEREAS, Said Hobart Hanson is indebted to his parents Perry 6 Hanson and Ruth E Hanson by reason of certain advances to him of Bums of money from time to time, and,

WHEREAS, the purpose and intent of this instrument is to insure repayment of said loans or advances by Hobart Hanson, and to protect and preserve the said real property for said purpose.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY First and Second Parties as follows:

1. First parties shall forthwith make, execute and deliver to second party their quit claim deed to the above described real property.

 Second party shall have the right to lease said property and collect all income therefrom.

 All income and rentals from said property shall be used for the following purposes by second party:

 (a) Pay all mortgage payments to The Lawrence Building and Loan Association as the same shall become due on said property ancluding taxes and insurance thereon, and the maintenance thereof.
(b) All remaining income shall be held in Trust by
