 The South Fifty-two (52) feet of Lot One Hundred Forty
 (140), and the West Sixty-two (62) feet of Lot
 One Hundred Forty-two (142), in Addition Two (2), in
 that part of the City of Lawrence formerly known as
 North Lawrence.

subject to a First Mortgage on the above described real estate to
 The Lawrence National Bank in the original amount of Six Thousand and
 no/100 Dollars (\$6,000.00), dated November 6, 1948, and recorded

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said part Y of the second part, and to its successors forever; PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this instrument is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Whereas, the said parties of the first part have this day executed and delivered their certain premissory note in writing to the part Y of the second part, payable at its office in the City of Kansas City, State of Missouri as follows, to-wit: \$43.10 on March 6, 1952, and \$43.10 on the 6th day of each month thereafter until a total of one hundred fifteen such monthly installments shall have been paid, followed by final payment of principal in the amount of \$43.50 on October 6, 1961;
 with interest on unpaid principal computed from February 6, 1952 at the rate of three percent per annum, payable monthly, beginning March 6, 1952.
