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This Mortgage Made this 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, in the year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine  
 Hundred and fifty-one, by and between Will H. Hayden and Mary R. Hayden,  
his wife, and Eugene Nunemaker and Pauline Nunemaker, also known as Pauline M.  
Nunemaker, his wife,  
 of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas parties of the first part, and  
 Reconstruction Finance Corporation

 Whereas, That said part Ies of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars to them in hand paid by the said part V of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he ye  
granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part V  
of the second part and to its /successors/ heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described tract, piece  
and parcel of land lying and situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:  
All that part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 12 South,  
RANGE 20 East, lying North of a point 50 feet distant from the center  
line of the Union Pacific Railroad right of way, less public highway,  
containing 77.24 acres, more or less,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors, heirs and assigns forever; PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this instrument is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Whereas, the said Will H. Hayden, Mary R. Hayden, Eugene Nunemaker & Pauline Nunemaker also known as Pauline M. Nunemaker he ye  
this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note, to writing to the part V of the second  
part, payable at office of Reconstruction Finance Corporation  
as follows, to-wit: \$200.00 on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1952; \$200.00 on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August,  
1952; \$200.00 on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1952; \$200.00 on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February,  
1953; and \$200.00 payable on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of each February, May, August and November  
hereafter to and including the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1954, together with interest at the  
rate of 3% per annum on the unpaid balance of the principal, computed quarterly, and  
payable on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1952, and quarterly thereafter, concurrently with principal  
payments, until the entire principal indebtedness has been paid in full.

Now, if the said Will H. Hayden, Mary R. Hayden, Eugene Nunemaker & Pauline Nunemaker also known as Pauline M. Nunemaker,  
shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, the sum of money in said note mentioned, with the interest thereon, according
