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This Mortgage Made this 24th day of October in the year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine  
Hundred and Fifty-one by and between

Howard H. Pine and Letta B. Pine, his wife

of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas parties of the first part, and  
Reconstruction Finance Corporation

party of the second part  
 Whereas, That said parties of the first part, to-wit and in consideration of the sum of  
 Two Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 (\$2,500.00) - - - Dollars  
 to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
 granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party  
 of the second part and to its successors and assigns forever, all of the following described tract, place,  
 and parcel of land lying and situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:  
 Beginning at a point 20 rods North of the Southwest corner  
 of the Northeast Quarter (NE<sup>1/4</sup>) of Section Nineteen (19),  
 Township Twelve (12), South of Range Twenty (20) East of the  
 6th P.M.; thence running east eighty (E80) rods; thence  
 North fifteen (N15) rods; thence West eighty (W80) rods;  
 thence South fifteen (S15) rods to the point of beginning,  
 containing seven and one-half ( $\frac{7}{2}$ ) acres.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said  
 party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever; PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this instrument  
 is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Whereas, the said parties of the first part  
 have this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to the party of the second part,  
 payable at its office in the City of Kansas City, State of Missouri  
 as follows, to-wit: \$22.00 on March 24, 1952, and \$22.00 on the 24th day of  
 each month thereafter until a total of one hundred twelve such monthly  
 installments shall have been paid, followed by final payment of principal  
 in the amount of \$56.00 on July 24, 1961;  
 with interest on the unpaid principal from February 24, 1952 at the  
 rate of three percent per annum, payable monthly, beginning March 24,  
 1952.
