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This Mortgage Made this 21th day of October in the year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine

 Whereas, That said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of
 Nine Hundred Thirty-seven and no/100 Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to its successors heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described tract piece and parcel of land lying and situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The North Half of Lot 10 in Addition 11, in that part of
 the city of Lawrence formerly known as North Lawrence.

(This mortgage is junior only to a first mortgage dated October 10, 1951 in favor
 of Harry A. Puckett, in the amount of \$1575.00.)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors heirs and assigns forever; PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this instrument is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Whereas, the said Thomas L. Lee and Maxine Lee have this day executed and delivered their certain premissory note in writing to the party of the second part, payable at office of Reconstruction Finance Corporation, Kansas City, Missouri, as follows, to-wit: \$10.00 on the 21th day of March, 1952, \$10.00 on the 21th day of each and every month thereafter to and including the 21th day of November, 1959, with a final payment of \$17.00 due December 21th, 1959, together with interest from the 21th day of February, 1952, at the rate of 3% per annum, computed monthly on the unpaid balances, and payable March 21th, 1952 and on the 21th day of each and every month thereafter until the principal indebtedness is paid in full.

Now, if the said Thomas L. Lee and Maxine Lee, his wife, shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, the sum of money in said note mentioned, with the interest thereon, according
