KANSAS FARM MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, Made the first day of October A. D. 1951 between Herbert W. Altenbernd, also known as Herbert Altenbernd, and Helen M. Altenbernd, individually and as husband and wife, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,

hereinafter (whether one or more in number) called Mortgagors, and The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, a Wisconsin corporation, having its principal place of business and post office address at 720 East Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee 2, Wisconsin, hereinafter called Mortgagee:

WITNESSETH, that Mortgagors, in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Mortgagee, forever, the following described Real Estate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:
