Witnesseth. That said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of  
 Five Thousand and no/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to its successors forever, all of the following described tract, piece, and parcel of land lying and situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit:  
 All that part of the North Half (N<sup>1</sup>/2) of the North Half (N<sup>1</sup>/2) of Lot No. Six (6), Section Nineteen (19), Township Thirteen (13), Range Twenty (20), lying East of the right of way of Union Pacific Railroad Company crossing said lot, containing 5.60 acres, more or less, excepting 23/100 of an acre more or less, conveyed to Union Pacific Railroad by deed recorded in Book 71, Page 573, and excepting tract conveyed to State of Kansas for highway containing .32 acres, more or less, shown in Book 137, Page 198.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors forever; PROVIDED ALWAYS, and this instrument is made, executed, and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

Witness, the said parties of the first part have this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to the party of the second part, payable at its office in the City of Kansas City, State of Missouri as follows: \$45.00 on January 8, 1952, and \$45.00 on the 8th day of each month thereafter until a total of one hundred ten such monthly installments shall have been paid, followed by final payment of principal in the amount of \$50.00 on March 8, 1961;

with interest on unpaid principal computed from April 8, 1952 at the rate of three percent per annum, payable monthly, beginning May 8, 1952.
