Line 2—A 66,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately three hundredth (1/100) of a mile in length, beginning at the southwest corner of Section Twenty-five (25) of Township Seven (7) South, Range Eighteen (18) East, Jefferson County, and extending southwesterly through the Nortonville Substation located in said quarter section, township, range and county.

Line 3—A 66,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately three hundredth (1/100) of a mile in length, beginning at the southwest corner of Section Twenty-five (25) of Township Seven (7) South, Range Eighteen (18) East, Jefferson County, and extending southwesterly through the Nortonville Substation located in said quarter section, township, range and county.

Line 4—A 22,000 volt, wood pole, electric transmission line, approximately three hundredth (1/100) of a mile in length, beginning at the southwest corner of Section Fourteen (14) of said township, range and county, and extending southwesterly through the Nortonville Substation located in said quarter section, township, range and county.
