DELINQUENT PRORATION FLEET REGISTRATION QUARTERLY PAYMENT INSTALLMENT

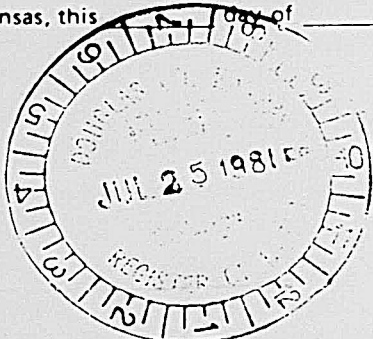
The State of Kansas claims a lien upon the vehicles listed on the reverse side of this Notice of Lien, and/or the attached page, and upon all other real and personal property of Owen E. Henderson DBA Gene's Trucking, of Route 1 in the city of Lecompton, Kansas, in the amount of \$ 1056.12.

Said lien is filed as provided for under K.S.A. 8-1, 115, Chapter 30, 1978 Session Laws. The 1st quarter Proration Fleet Registration Installment was due and payable on the 1st day of January, 19 81, and remains unpaid on the 21st day of July, 19 81.

The lien includes the delinquent installment in the amount of \$ 103.73; penalty in the sum equal to ten percent (10%) of the original total annual fleet prorate fee (10% X \$ 414.92), and amount of \$ 41.49; the entire balance remaining of Proration Fleet Registration Payment, an amount of \$ 1014.63; a total due and payable in the amount of \$ 1056.12.

"When any installment payment has been delinquent more than ten (10) days, the division of vehicles shall forthwith file a notice of lien in the office of the register of deeds of the county where the principal place of business of such fleet owner is located, or any county where the vehicles of such fleet are based, or any other county in which such owner has any property. A copy of said notice of lien shall be mailed to the fleet owner so delinquent. Said notice of lien shall set forth the name and address of the fleet owner, the amount of the proportional fleet registration fee and penalty payable and unpaid, and a description of the fleet vehicles to which applicable. It shall be the duty of each register of deeds in this state to index and file immediately all such notices of lien in the manner provided in the cases of financing statements, and no fee shall be charged for filing and indexing. The division of vehicles shall issue a release of lien upon payment of the proportional fleet registration fee and penalty payable by such fleet owner, and such person may file the same with the register of deeds of any county in which such notice of lien has been filed, and no fee shall be charged for the release of lien."
